When is Short-Term or Respite Care a good choice?

- An individual is recovering from an illness, injury, or surgery and is not ready or prepared to care for themselves in their own home.
- A full-time caregiver needs a deserved break or "respite" from the rigors of caregiving.
- A full-time caregiver cannot provide care for a short-term period due to a commitment, occasion, illness, or other obligation.

Optional services not included in the daily Short-Term / Respite Care fee include:

- Assistance with personal care needs
- Medication Management
- Homemaking Services
- Therapies—physical, occupational, speech, or cardiac rehabilitation
- Personal Laundry
- Beauty Shop/Barber Shop services
- Transportation to and from medical appointments
- Lifeline Emergency Response System

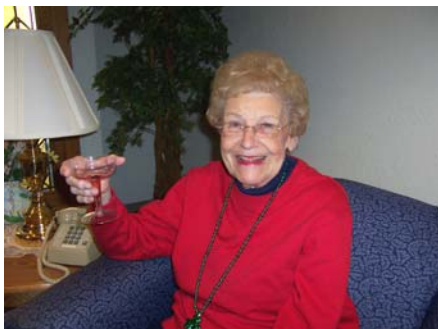


What is the admission process?

We encourage individuals, caregivers, and families to make an appointment with the housing coordinator. At this meeting, we will give you a tour of our facility and apartments, and discuss your needs, health status, preferences, schedules, and special requests. A care plan will be established to ensure that we are providing the amenities and healthcare services you need to feel comfortable, safe, and right at home!

What does Short-Term / Respite Care cost?

The daily cost for Respite Care varies depending upon the optional services that are requested by the resident and family. Insurance (commercial, Medicare B/Medicaid) will be billed when appropriate. The patient and/or family is responsible for cost of care not covered by insurance or Medicare. Arrangements for payment should be made at time of admission.
