

ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

1. In order to be considered for the Radiography program, a completed application must be sent in prior to or on the deadline date of November 1. Any application postmarked after the deadline will not be considered for admission into the program until the following year.
2. Partial applications will **not** be considered for admission into the program.
3. For an application to be considered complete, the following items **must** be included:
 - An application form complete with all pertinent information.
 - Transcripts from **all** academic facilities that the applicant has attended. This includes high school, technical school, and college transcripts.
 - ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer test scores, if applicable. (Please do not assume that the ACT or SAT scores will accompany the high school transcripts.)
 - References: Please note that three reference surveys need to be submitted for consideration into the program. Survey forms can be found on-line by clicking on the Admission form link.
 1. Reference surveys **must** be sent from the reference themselves and not from the applicant.
 2. Reference surveys submitted from the applicant will **not** be accepted.
 3. Reference surveys completed by family members will **not** be accepted.
 4. High school applicants should include at least one reference from a counselor or teacher and an employer, if applicable. Applicants who have graduated high school should include references from supervisors, employers, and/or college professors.
 - A 750-1000 word essay on why you have chosen Radiography as a career field. Essays should be typed, and double-spaced.
 - \$30 application fee. Checks should be made out to: St. Joseph's Hospital.
